

Exhibit Objectives for Educators

New! Airplane Exhibit

- Discuss flight, how things/animals fly and human attempts to make objects fly
- Explore travel, how long it takes to fly to different parts of the globe
- Who in your group has traveled the farthest?
- If you could go anywhere in the world, where would it be?
- Role play: Pilot, air traffic control, flight attendant, passenger
- Explore professions in the Airline industry

Post Office

- Teach Students how to address envelopes properly
- Teach students how mail is processed
- Explore professions in the US Postal Service

Grocery Store

- Explore the food pyramid
- Learn to select foods for a healthy balanced diet including fruits and vegetables
- Learn math and language skills
- Learn the importance of cooperation and respect
- Solve problems and develop self-esteem
- Role play: cashier and customer
- Stock shelves using labels that match grocery item
- Assist classmates in bagging groceries
- Explore a profession in the food industry

Beauty Shop

- Learn the importance of proper hygiene
- Develop social skills
- Discover and adopt a sense of individual style
- Explore a profession in the cosmetic industry

Dentist Office

- History of dentistry
- Learn anatomy of teeth
- Gain knowledge of how to brush and floss properly
- Become comfortable in a dentist's office due to exposure
- Role play opportunities: Dentist, Dental Hygienist, patient
- Explore professions in the industry

Radiology Department

- Learn about the skeletal system
- View real X-rays
- Explore information on computer
- Discover how X-rays were invented, who invented them and what they are
- See actual picture of a MRI of the brain
- Explore professions in the industry

Doctor's Office

- Explore the medical world
- Learn about the many parts of the body
- Become comfortable at the doctor's office through exposure
- Role play: Doctor, Nurse, Patient, Emergency Medical Personnel
- Explore professions in the industry

School Room

- Chance for the students to teach the teachers
- Role play: teacher, student
- Use imagination
- Spark interest in field

Play Set

- Encourage physical activity
- Increase social skills
- Learn to play together
- Develop problem solving skills as they find their way through the play set

Performing Arts Stage

- Sing, dance, imagine, and play
- Students will work in cooperative groups
- Increase creativity in child

- Learn social skills
- Pretend to be a train conductor
- Explore our “Push Button Train Neighborhood”

Fire House Exhibit

- Learn helping and social skills
- Learn about our community heroes
- Pretend to be a brave firefighter
- Learn when to call 9-1-1
- Develop fine and gross motor skills
- Pretend to drive a real 1927 fire truck
- Spark interest in professions in the industry
- Fire Safety
